**NEW:**

**BE AWARE A.R.S. §16-904(F)**

- A committee that does not exceed its five hundred dollar threshold, MUST file to Terminate at the end of the election cycle for which it was formed, shall file a termination statement as prescribed by section 16-914 and shall dispose of any surplus monies as otherwise provided by law.
- A committee that fails to file a termination statement within 90 days after the end of the election cycle for which it was formed, shall pay a civil penalty of \$100.
