**ORDER OF STANDARD PROBATION**

**TO THE JUVENILE NAMED ABOVE:**

**IT IS ORDERED** pursuant to ARS 8-341 that the above-named juvenile is awarded to the care of the current custodial parent or legal guardian under the control and supervision of the Yuma County Juvenile Probation Department until \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_, with the following terms and conditions:

- \_\_\_\_\_ 1. I will obey all laws and will notify my probation officer of any law enforcement contact within 24 hours.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 2. I will obey the reasonable rules and requests of my parent(s)/legal guardian(s), probation officer and school officials.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 3.
  - a. I will notify my probation officer before moving or changing my telephone number.
  - b. I will remain inside my home between 6:00 p.m. and 6:30 a.m., unless I am in the physical presence of my parent(s)/legal guardian(s), in school, or an activity which has been approved by my probation officer.
  - c. I will not leave Yuma County without permission from my probation officer. I must submit a request 48 hours in advance of the day that I want to leave. If I leave my home for more than 24 hours and my whereabouts are unknown a warrant may be issued for my arrest.

  - a. I will stay in school or be gainfully employed. If I am not a full-time student or fully employed, I will be required to participate in the Community Restitution Program for at least 18 hours per week.
  - b. I will follow and abide by all school attendance regulations and procedures. I will notify my probation officer by 8:30 a.m. on any school day that I am absent.
  - c. If I am not in school that day for any reason, including illness or suspension, I will not leave my home unless it is for a doctor's appointment or court activity.
  - d. I will notify my probation officer of any changes in my school, or work status immediately. If I am suspended from school. I will be required to attend the Community Restitution Program until I am able to return to school.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 5. I will report to my assigned probation officer on the \_\_\_\_\_ of each month.

  - a. I will not associate with anyone who is on probation, protective supervision or parole.
  - b. I will have no contact of any kind with any victim(s), co-defendant(s) or witnesses of any offense which caused me to be placed on probation.
  - c. I will not associate with any gang member, participate in gang-related activities, or wear or display gang-related logos, clothing or paraphernalia identifying gang membership or association.
  - d. I will not get a tattoo while on probation.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 7. I will submit my person and property to search and/or seizure by the probation department, with or without probable cause or a warrant, as directed by any probation officer.

- \_\_\_\_\_ 8. I will not possess any deadly weapon, firearm, or simulated deadly weapon or firearm, or associate with anyone who is illegally in possession of a deadly weapon.
- \_\_\_\_\_ 9. a. I will not possess or attempt to possess, use, sell or distribute alcoholic beverages, marijuana, dangerous or narcotic drugs, drug paraphernalia, toxic vapors or prescription or non-prescription medication in violation of any law.
- b. I will not possess or attempt to possess, use, sell or distribute any uncontrolled or unregulated synthetic compounds or psychotropic substances, such as Spice or salvia divinorum, which are mood altering or affect mental activity, behavior or perception.
- c. I will not associate with anyone who is illegally consuming or possessing alcohol, drugs or drug paraphernalia, or wear any drug related logos or clothing.
- d. I will submit to drug tests (breath, saliva or urine) as directed by my probation officer. I will not attempt to alter any sample that I provide for a drug test.

You are expected to repay your parent(s)/legal guardian(s), if they pay these fees. If you become 60 days delinquent on your probation fees, a probation violation may be filed.

**I. JUVENILE ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF CONDITIONS OF PROBATION AND MY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

I have received and understand the conditions of Standard Probation. I understand that any violation of any condition of probation could result in a violation of probation hearing, at which time the Judge of the Juvenile Court may revoke my probation, and issue an Order of Commitment to the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections (ADJC) or impose any other consequence or placement. Additionally, I understand that my probation term can be extended if the court determines that it is in my, or the public's, best interest to require continued supervision, pursuant to ARS 8-341(B)(1), (2), (3), (4), (5), and (6).

**II. PARENTAL ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF CONDITIONS OF THE JUVENILE PROBATION AND PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY:**

Pursuant to ARS 8-234, the Court finds that an Order of Disposition has been made concerning the above-named child and that the proposed conduct of the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) may assist in the rehabilitation of the child. It is proposed that the parent(s)/legal guardian(s) comply with the following:

1. Cooperate in any treatment plan and the implementation of the terms of probation.
2. Promptly report any violation of your child’s probation to the Juvenile Probation Department.
3. Provide transportation for the juvenile to participate in probation activities and programs when necessary.
4. Notify the Juvenile Probation Department before changing your place of residence or telephone number.
5. Not prevent or hinder a search without a warrant, and without probable cause, of the juvenile’s person, clothing, personal effects, and the exterior, interior and outbuildings of any dwelling over which you have control and to which the juvenile has direct access.
6.
  - a. Pay \$60.00 per month probation supervision fee, payable today and on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of each month while the juvenile is on probation, pursuant to ARS 8-241(A). If you become 60 days delinquent on the probation fees, a violation of probation petition may be filed against the juvenile.
  - b. Pay a treatment fee in the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_ per referral, pursuant to ARS 8-234(D).
  - c. Pay a Victim Fee in the amount of \$25.00, if assessed.
  - d. Pay an Attorney Fee in the amount of \$\_\_\_\_\_, if assessed.
  - e. Pay a Detention Fee in the amount of \$20.00 per day your child is incarcerated in the Yuma County Juvenile Detention facility.
7. Allow information to be released to the Juvenile Probation Department by school officials and treatment staff.
8. Attend the Parent Orientation Program as directed by the probation officer, if ordered by the court.

You have the right to a hearing before any Court Order is issued commanding you to do these things. However, you may agree to a Court Order without a hearing.

\_\_\_\_\_ I agree to do these things and the Court may issue an Order without a hearing commanding me to do these things. I understand that if I fail to follow the Court’s order, I may be held in contempt and be fined or put in jail.

\_\_\_\_\_ I do not agree to do these things, and I want a hearing before the Court before any such Order is issued.

I have received and understand the conditions of my child’s probation and understand that I must comply with the parental responsibilities outlined above. I also understand that failure to comply with this court order, encouraging violations of this order, or through my actions or inactions causing my child to violate probation may result in appearance before the Judge of the Juvenile Court on an Order to Show Cause for Contempt of Court, and I may be punished by up to 30 days in jail and/or a \$1,000.00 fine.

**NOTICE OF LOSS OF RIGHT TO POSSESS FIREARM**

Pursuant to ARS 13-904(H), a person who is adjudicated delinquent under ARS 8-341(R) does not have the right to carry or possess a gun or firearm.

Pursuant to ARS 13-912(01), a person who is adjudicated delinquent and whose period of probation has been completed may have his/her rights to possess or carry a gun or firearm restored by the Judge who discharges the person at the end of his term of probation.

A person who is adjudicated delinquent and who has been discharged from probation, on proper application, may have his/her right to carry or possess a gun or firearm restored by the Judge of the Juvenile Court in the county where the person was adjudicated delinquent or his successors. The Clerk of the Superior Court shall process the application on the request of the person involved or the person's attorney. The applicant shall serve a copy of the application to the County Attorney.

If the person's adjudication was for a dangerous offense, under ARS 13-705, a serious offense as defined in ARS 13-706, Burglary in the First Degree, Burglary in the Second Degree or Arson, the person may not file for the restoration of his/her right to possess or carry a gun or firearm until the person attains thirty (30) years of age. If the person's adjudication was for any other felony offense, the person may not file for the restoration of his right to possess or carry a gun or firearm for two (2) years from the date of his discharge from probation.

**I UNDERSTAND THAT I MAY NOT CARRY OR POSSESS A GUN OR FIREARM FOR THE REST OF MY LIFE, UNLESS AND UNTIL I GET A COURT ORDER ALLOWING ME TO DO SO.**
