Adopted Codes in Yuma County

The Yuma County Building Safety Division will begin application and/or enforcement of the 2012 Building and Residential codes for new plan submittals and permit applications beginning January 1, 2014. Plan submittals received after January 1, 2016 will need to demonstrate compliance with the 2012 Mechanical, Plumbing, Fuel Gas and 2014 National Electric Codes.
