



CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

SIGNIFICANT NON-ROUTINE PROJECT

Flood Control Construction Projects – Nine projects to improve the County’s ability to minimize the impact of and protect life and property from flooding. The fiscal year 2014/15 budget is \$16,443,677.

Road Construction Projects – Twenty five projects to improve the County’s roadways, bridges, and drainage structures to better serve County communities. The fiscal year 2014/15 budget is \$14,469,199.

Administration Annex Project – This project will renovate a portion of the annex building for additional office space. The fiscal year 2014/15 budget is \$4,484,751.

El Prado Estates: New Sanitary Sewer Force Main – This project will construct a new single-use force main to connect to an existing lift station wet well to reduce gas emissions and corrosion. The fiscal year 2014/15 budget is \$1,059,736.

Justice Center/Historic Courthouse e-Courtroom Equipment Replacement – This project will replace obsolete and unsupported equipment and software that are part of the courtroom audio-video recording system. The fiscal year 2014/15 budget is \$303,956.
