

**NOTICE OF THE
YUMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

On May 16, 2016, the Yuma County Board of Supervisors adopted a Tentative Budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017. Pursuant to A.R.S. §42-17103, et seq., printed below are a summary of the total estimated revenues and expenditures by fund type (Schedule A) and primary and secondary property tax levies for all districts (Schedule B). Truth in Taxation calculations are as follows:

Yuma County hereby notifies all property taxpayers of Yuma County that it intends to maintain the County's primary property taxes at the same levy as the tax year 2015 (Fiscal Year 2015-2016) level, \$27,036,032. This proposed levy is exclusive of increased primary property taxes received from new construction. The levy is also exclusive of any changes that may occur from a property tax levy for voter approved bonded indebtedness or budget and tax overrides. To maintain the same levy, Yuma County's primary property taxes on a \$100,000 home will increase from \$241.32 to \$246.84. This is the result of an overall decrease in assessed values.

Yuma County hereby notifies all property taxpayers of the Yuma County Library District that it intends to raise the Yuma County Library District's secondary property taxes over last year's level. The Yuma County Library District is proposing an increase in secondary property taxes of \$89,394 or 1.33%. This proposed levy is exclusive of increased secondary property taxes received from new construction. The levy is also exclusive of any changes that may occur from a property tax levy for voter approved bonded indebtedness or budget and tax overrides. The Yuma County Library District's secondary property taxes on a \$100,000 home will increase from \$59.83 to \$62.02.

Yuma County hereby notifies all property taxpayers of the Yuma County Flood Control District that it intends to maintain the Yuma County Flood Control District's secondary property taxes at the same levy as the tax year 2015 (Fiscal Year 2015-2016) level, \$2,528,924. This proposed levy is exclusive of increased secondary property taxes received from new construction. The levy is also exclusive of any changes that may occur from a property tax levy for voter approved bonded indebtedness or budget and tax overrides. Yuma County Flood Control District's secondary property taxes on a \$100,000 home will remain that same at \$27.94.

Pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431, et seq., NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Yuma County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing and special meeting at 9:00 a.m., Monday, June 20, 2016, to hear oral and/or written comments concerning the Final Adopted Budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017, establishment of tax levies, and for adoption of same. The hearing will be held in the Yuma County Board of Supervisors' Auditorium, 198 S. Main Street, Yuma, Arizona. The Budget encompasses all taxing districts directed by the Board of Supervisors including the Flood Control, Health, Jail, Library and Improvement Districts. All interested citizens are invited to attend and comment on the budget. Following the hearing, the Board will consider final action to adopt the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 County budget.
