Pursuant to Supreme Court Administrative Order 2016-25 issued by Arizona Chief Justice Scott Bales on March 30, 2016, the administrative control and oversight of day-to-day operations of the San Luis Municipal Court and authority to assign judges as needed to conduct court business was granted to the Honorable Maria Elena Cruz, Presiding Judge, Superior Court in Yuma County.


Further, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes, §22-121 and the Code of Judicial Administration §1-305 E, the Presiding Judge may appoint judges pro tempore on a temporary full-time basis.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Cora Romine is appointed as Judge Pro Tempore/Administrative Manager for the San Luis Municipal Court effective May 23, 2016, until further orders from this court. The duties of the Judge Pro Tempore/Administrative Manager include, but are not limited to, acting as a Judge Pro Tempore as needed and functioning as administrative manager of San Luis Municipal Court. For purposes of this order, the functions of the administrative manager will be to maintain oversight and control of all San Luis Municipal Court records. Court records include paper records, electronic records, case and financial records and cash, checks, money orders, receipt books, check books and other records used to conduct court business.

1           **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Cora Romine shall receive compensation at the  
2 rate of \$35.00/hour; a vehicle provided by the City of San Luis, and reimbursement for fuel  
3 costs associated with her round-trip daily commute from Wellton, Arizona to San Luis,  
4 Arizona. Any and all compensation and expenses incurred shall be paid directly to Ms.  
5 Romine by the City of San Luis, Arizona.

6           **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the instant order supersedes Yuma County  
7 Superior Court Administrative Order 2016-11.
