The Arizona Local Rules of Practice—Superior Court for Yuma County were first adopted on October 1, 1975, and have been amended on several occasions. The most recent amendment was effective October 1, 2015. The Yuma County Superior Court and the local Civil Bar have recognized the need for revisions consistent with the local needs and practices.

Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 11 of the Arizona Constitution,
IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1. The Yuma County Civil Rules Committee is established.
2. PURPOSE: The Committee shall periodically conduct a review and analysis of the Yuma County Superior Court Local Rules of Practice, review all proposals to amend the Yuma County Superior Court Local Rules of Practice, recommend revisions and additional rules as the Committee deems appropriate, entertain comments concerning the rules, and provide reports to this Court, as appropriate.
3. MEMBERSHIP: The membership of the Committee is as follows, and for the terms as indicated:

2.	Jack Meerchaum	New Appointment – Term Expires August 25, 2018
3.	Bruce Jensen	New Appointment – Term Expires August 25, 2018

- 2 5. Mary K. Boyte Henderson New Appointment – Term Expires August 25, 2018
- 3 6. Andy Fila New Appointment – Term Expires August 25, 2018

4 The Presiding Judge may appoint additional members as may be necessary. The Hon. Lawrence
5 Kenworthy shall be the Chairman of the Committee and shall calls meetings as necessary.

6 4. REPORTS: If the Committee concludes that the Superior Court should consider amendments
7 to the Local Rules, it shall draft and file the necessary petitions to amend the Yuma
8 County Superior Court Local Rules of Practice.
