



**YUMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
RESOLUTION NO. 09-14**

**APPROVING THE LEVY OF ADMINISTRATIVE  
FEES FOR PUBLIC HEARINGS AND OTHER  
COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH TOWING VEHICLES  
IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARS §28-3513**

WHEREAS: Arizona Revised Statutes (ARS) §28-3511 requires the towing of motor vehicles operating on public roadways by drivers with revoked and suspended drivers licenses for certain offenses, mostly alcohol-related violations; and

WHEREAS: The Arizona State Legislature further expanded this law to include all suspensions and revocations and added the violation of ignition interlock device requirements; and

WHEREAS: The Yuma County Sheriff's Office has the responsibility and the authority to order vehicles in violation of this statute to be towed; and

WHEREAS: During the 2008 calendar year has towed some 625 vehicles that required an administrative hearing to release the vehicle to its rightful owner; and


WHEREAS: ARS§ 28-3513 allows the law enforcement agency to charge an administrative fee up to \$150.00 per vehicle for costs associated with the administrative costs relating to the removal, immobilization, impoundment, storage or release of a vehicle; and

WHEREAS: The administrative fees collected shall be transmitted to the county treasurer for deposit in a special fund established by the county to offset the costs associated with the task required by under ARS §§28-872 and 28-3511 and include staff time, mailings, copying, printing, post-impound hearings and research and training.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yuma County Board of Supervisors hereby:

1. Establishes the administrative fee in the amount of \$75.00 for each vehicle towed pursuant to ARS § 28-3513 and A.R.S § 11-251.08; and,
2. Authorizes the Sheriff of Yuma County to collect said fees for deposit to the county treasurer as authorized under ARS §28-3513(F)(2).


