A RESOLUTION OF THE YUMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DESCRIBING THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY COMMISSION

**WHEREAS:** On November 17, 1997 the Yuma County Board of Supervisors (Board) adopted Resolution No. 97-78 establishing the Yuma County Parks and Recreation Department and the Yuma County Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission; and,

**WHEREAS:** On July 6, 1998 the Board adopted Resolution No. 98-61 pertaining to the approval of parks and recreation organizational responsibilities; and,

**WHEREAS:** The Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission has been established to advise the Board on matters related to County parks and recreation programs, as required under the provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes §11-934(D), and for said purposes, the Board of Supervisors has appointed a Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission; and,

**WHEREAS:** The Board is desirous of providing lands for parks and recreational uses while minimizing the expenditure of County funds for the acquisition, improvement, operation, and maintenance of said lands; and,

**WHEREAS:** The Board desires to revise the powers and duties of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission as presented in Resolution Nos. 97-78 and 98-61.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

1. Resolution No. 97-78, paragraph 7, section P&R 3 is hereby rescinded.
2. Resolution No. 98-61 is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

3. The powers and duties of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission shall be as follows:
  - A. The Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission shall act in an advisory capacity to the Board and may, from time to time, and shall, when requested by the Board, make a report or recommendation in connection with matters relating to County parks and recreation programs.
  - B. The Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission may prepare and recommend to the Board a comprehensive plan for County parks and recreation programs for the purpose of bringing about coordinated physical development of County parks in accordance with the present and future needs of the County for parks and recreation facilities. The comprehensive plan shall be developed so as to conserve the natural resources of the County, to ensure efficient expenditure of public funds, to minimize the expenditure of County funds, and to promote the health, safety, convenience, and general welfare of the public in utilization of County parks and recreation facilities and programs.
  - C. The Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission may make recommendations to the Board on the establishment of broad policies and long-range programs for the acquisition, planning, development, maintenance and operation of County parks.
  - D. For purposes of maintenance and operation of parks, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission, shall identify and recommend non-profit service organizations and clubs to maintain and operate specific County parks or specific portions of County parks to the Board.
  - E. For purposes of land acquisition for and improvements to County parks, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission, shall identify and recommend grant funding opportunities to the Board.
  - F. The Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission may make recommendations to the Board on fees to be paid for the use of County parks facilities.
  - G. The Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission may assemble information on programs and activities of the Parks and Recreation Department and make recommendations to the Board.

- H. The Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission, in the performance of its duties, may request, through the Director of Public Works or his/her designee, information from other County departments and agencies in relation to its work.
- I. The Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission shall have such other powers, duties, and authorities as the Board may, from time to time and pursuant to official action of the Board, direct.
