

YUMA COUNTY EMPLOYEES IN THE EVENT OF A WORKPLACE INJURY



- 1) **Injured employee notifies supervisor of incident.
If injury is life or limb-threatening, call 911 immediately.**
- 2) **Injured employee and supervisor call TriageNow.**

- 3) **TriageNow Registered Nurse gathers pertinent information and guides the injured employee to appropriate medical care.**
- 4) **TriageNow notifies medical facility that injured employee is arriving and sends incident report to County Human Resources.**
- 5) **Employee's supervisor completes *Supervisor's Report of Industrial Injury* and sends it to County Human Resources.**

**Call TriageNow prior to seeking any treatment for non-life-threatening emergencies
and before leaving the job site when possible.**
