**COVID-19 Safety Precautions at the Juvenile Court
Updated 6-17-20**

Our isolation from the public has been extended until at least July 15th. We continue taking extra precautions over the next few weeks. We have extra masks for employees in Administration.

May 5, 2020:

All staff were required to wear a facial mask, or covering in the following situations;
All times when you are around anyone who comes to your assigned worked area, or office.
All times when you are in the building and away from your assigned work area or office.
This practice is ongoing

May 11, 2020:

We began allowing the parents of detained you the option of attending court hearing in person. Court Security ensures that all public entering the building are wearing masks and were instructing to provide one if needed.
This practice is ongoing

May 18, 2020:

All staff were required to take their own temperature with an infrared thermometer, when they arrive to work. This includes all staff assigned to the court building, the detention building and Aztec High School. If your temperature is 100 degrees or higher, you will not be allowed to stay at work. You will need to immediately leave the premises and contact your supervisor. You will not be allowed back at work until you are fever free for at least 72 hours. Options on steps to take were provided to staff.
This practice is ongoing

June 8, 2020:

Began installing Plexiglass barriers at Security, Aztec Office and several conference rooms.
Began developing "Return to normal plan, even though that date is unknown.

All in person appearances at the YCJJC, including courtroom appearances, should be kept to an absolute minimum. Telephonic court appearances are strongly encouraged.

If you are required to appear in person, a facemask is required.

If a payment is required, using a debit or credit card via the telephone is strongly encouraged. If a payment must be made by check place the check in an envelope and give it to security at the front entrance. Your canceled check will be your receipt.

All of us at the YCJJC are committed to maintaining a healthy and safe environment for the public, the children in our custody and our employees. Staff has been instructed to thoroughly clean high contact areas of the YCJJC.
