Administrative Order
2025-22

The Arizona Constitution vests the Chief Justice of the Arizona Supreme Court with administrative oversight of the judicial department of this state. The Chief Justice has delegated this constitutional administrative supervisory authority to the presiding judge of the superior court of each county through the issuance of Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79. This delegated administrative supervision includes the authority for the presiding judge of the superior court to reassign personnel among the judicial department in the county, which includes, among others, the Superior Court and the Superior Court Clerk's Office.

This administrative oversight additionally includes authority over the administrative structure of the Superior Court and all of its services, including those that provide administrative support in the areas of human resources, finance, technology, training, and others.

Having determined that a staff transfer is necessary to best serve the needs of the Yuma County judicial department, and

Pursuant to the Arizona Constitution, Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79, and Rule 9.02(C) of the Rules of the Judicial Merit System for Classified and Unclassified Employees of the Superior Court System in Yuma County,

IT IS ORDERED transferring Michael Griego, Human Resources Specialist, from the Superior Court Clerk's Office to the Superior Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Michael Griego, Human Resources Specialist, shall be under the supervision of the Director of Superior Court Human Resources and shall assume duties as assigned by the Director of Superior Court Human Resources or a designee.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED transferring Rachel Pino, Receptionist/Clerk, from the Superior Court Clerk's Office to the Superior Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Rachel Pino, Receptionist/Clerk, shall be under the supervision of the Deputy Court Administrator and shall assume duties as assigned by the Deputy Court Administrator or a designee.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the funds and budget authority for these two positions
2 shall be transferred from the Superior Court Clerk's Office to the budget of the Superior Court
3 in Yuma County. The transfer shall be accomplished through budget amendments.
