1. Chairman proclaims the week of May 17-23, 2026 to be "Public Works Week" in Yuma County.
2. Presentation of "The Mix with Yuma County and El Condado Informado" by Yuma 77, the Yuma County Government Channel.

1. *Assessor:* Approve Tax Roll Corrections as listed in batch dated May 18, 2026, pursuant to ARS Title 42, Chapter 16, Article VI.
2. *Financial Services:* a) Approve the Accounts Payable Demands issued in the total amount of \$6,312,554.66 for the period of April 16, 2026 through April 24, 2026, inclusive of all county departments and Housing A/P batches; and, b) Approve Payroll issued in the amount of \$2,367,844.85 for the pay period ending March 28, 2026, paid April 03, 2026. 3. *Clerk of the Board:* Approve the minutes for the May 4, 2026 Regular Session.
4. *Free Library District :* Confirm the appointment of Steven Birmingham to represent Yuma County on the Yuma County Free Library District Board of Trustees for a three-year term beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2029.
5. *Recorder:* Approve ballot drop box locations for the July 21, 2026 Primary Election and November 3, 2026 General Election at the Foothills Library, Main Library, San Luis Library, Somerton Library, Wellton Library, San Luis Medical Mall, Yuma County Recorder's Office, and previous Yuma County Board Auditorium.

6. *Recorder:* Approve and authorize the Chairman to sign the intergovernmental agreement between the Yuma County Board of Supervisors and the Yuma County Recorder's Office for the operation and management of the ballot drop boxes placed at the library locations, for a term of two years, effective April 1, 2026.
7. *Treasurer:* Authorize and approve the retention of Andrew Pappas, of the law firm of Osborn Maledon, P.A., as lead attorney at the hourly rate of \$695, to serve as lead counsel for the Yuma County Treasurer in connection with an investigation involving his office; and the retention of Sarah Lawson as associate attorney at the hourly rate of \$420. In addition, authorize Treasurer David Alexandre, or his designee, to sign the engagement letter from Osborn Maledon.

2. *Financial Services:* Discussion and possible action to adopt and authorize the Chairman to sign Resolution No. 2026-22, authorizing the submission to Yuma County voters a permanent adjustment to the County's base expenditure limitation in the amount of \$6.2 million at the November 3, 2026 General Election as permitted by Article IX, Section 20(6) of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Revised Statute 41-563.
3. *County Administration:* Discussion and possible action on expanding Spanish-language access and multilingual digital engagement with a presentation by Communications Administrative Director Dave Nash.


